- **Predictive analytics and AI-assisted diagnostics** in supply chain operations.
- **Addressing ethical considerations** and data privacy concerns in AI-driven SCM solutions.
- **Integration of AI with existing SCM systems** to enhance the 4 R's of supply chain management: reliability, responsiveness, resilience, and relationships.

- **AI-based solutions** for controlling costs, avoiding supply shortages, and improving supply chain sustainability.

This Special Issue aims to showcase cutting-edge research and practical applications that highlight the potential of AI in shaping the future of SCM. Submissions should demonstrate originality, technical rigor, and relevance to the evolving landscape of supply chain management.
